On that day, the NFSC will be encouraging our 250,000+ supporters to attend participating churches

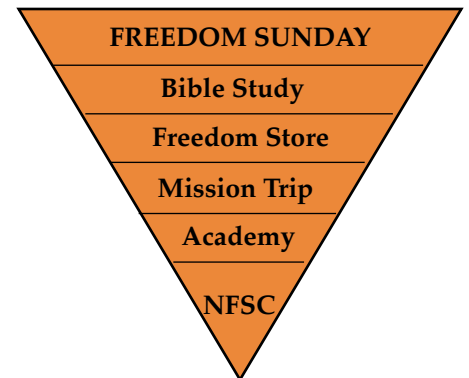
